Platonic Surrealism and Block Universes

Platonic Surrealism

Is a framework, much like neutral monism or metaphysical idealism, which stresses that both mind and matter are subprocesses within a higher order informational matrix called "POTENTIALITY' the sum total of all possible properties and interactions between properties, which exists well beyond space and time.

Besides POTENTIALITY, one key property is AWARENESS, which is the ability to perceive reflexively back on itself. This AWARENESS has a tendency to 'loop back on itself like a mobius strip, and this fundamental smallest (and largest unit of being) is called a monad or a potentiality node.


So you may as well 'try' if you like; you'll either succeed or you won't.

For all of endless time, Awareness dives into those lamps and dives right back out of them,


for the joy of the ontological shock of it all.

The Problem of Suffering (Atman, Jiva and Samsara)

Overview

I will use some Eastern philosophical terms in this essay, as their cultures developed this sort of conversation quite superbly over thousands of years. The "West" has barely begun to discuss it in the same 'cosmic sense', for but a few years.

My focus in this life has largely revolved around understanding the role of extreme suffering, complex PTSD and spiritual experience, as well as Autism. But those are just words. Let's examine the problem of Atman and Jiva, "Living in the same body".

Atman is a Sanskrit word meaning roughly "eternal, transcendent, unchanging divine self" from beyond all space and time, equal to the supreme reality Brahman. In various systems, including Advaita Vedanta, which is a major school of nondualist philosophy that proclaims as it's core tenant "Atman and Brahman are one".

Now this sounds just lovely doesn't it? That humans are part of the infinite bedrock of being, functionally from a western standpoint 'one with supreme GOD'?

Unfortunately while the experience of Atman, which is considered to be beyond all change and suffering, is quite 'ducky', the experience of the jiva is not so nice.

Jiva is a Sanskrit term that refers to the individual soul or self. It is often understood as a part of the Atman, the ultimate reality, but temporarily bound to the cycle of birth and death (samsara).

So, to put it in very simple Western terms, the real question is, "Why is 'God' an asshole?"

Now we aren't going to dwell on this exact question so much in this essay, but let's stipulate the following:

The infinite reality does everything that it wants to do, and the motives and realities associated with thorny topics are likely not easily understood, but as a Christian might say, "The clay cannot speak against the potter". Well, that doesn't sound so ducky at all.

Now a nondualist practitioner might say, "well you are both the infinite and the finite. The unbounded and the bounded. So it's all 'alright'". It's fair.

There is a legitimate point there. If only one being actually exists, and that being likes hurting themselves, then that is that being's business is it not? If 'God' is a cutter, that might make him/her a 'masochist' but not a sadist, as all the little lives within the infinite Brahman

are rather illusory, the product of maya (Maya is a Sanskrit term that refers to the illusion or delusion that prevents us from perceiving the true nature of reality.)

So, technically by the numbers, there's nothing wrong with a being torturing or allowing to be tortured, little 'imaginary cells within it's own body".

Really it can't be argued. This is acceptable from that standpoint. It's rather like the theosophical problem called "the problem of evil". That is the problem of why an infinitely powerful, omniscient, and omnipresent (and presumably loving) God is an asshole?

The answer to that of course, is that 'God' is evil, and that is not a problem. Remember the potter and the clay, and throw in a little predestination from Augustine and John Calvin, and that answer works just fine (you may have to admit that God can do anything that he wants and that by definition such acts are not 'evil'). But that explanation still blows, as the say. It really does.

It's like God is suffering form dissociative identity disorder, and as a matter of fact, that is exactly what Bernardo Kastrup, a widely recognized philosopher writes.

Is the assholery of God a problem that we should all care about? Does this affect everyone equally? Is there anything that can be doing about this? These are the questions we will address.

This Truly is Messed up, for all Parties Concerned

Now lots of good, regular folks, don't pay this problem much mind. Just guzzle alcohol on Friday nights, eat lots of barbecue wings (or conversely caviar, fancy cheese and wines or whatever your thing is, based upon economic class) and keep yourself distracted from the gnawing in your innermost self.

Or conversely sell 'your mind/soul' to some human-created religion, and cram into place, probably uncritically, the 'solution' posited by that religion, all the while wishing anyone who disagrees with you (rocks your very tiny and unseaworthy boat) to go to hell, or whatever, but to just get out of your face. Don't even give me the hypocrisy of 'hate the sin, love the sinner'. That's just cover for "My invisible friend can beat up your invisible friend, and I'll pretend to be more holy than thou, as cover for wishing you into hell, to protect my feeble facade, so that I can feel better." I mean, as far as any Christian knows, they could be judged a goat not a sheep and sent to eternal torment and they have no way of knowing until they die or are prematurely judged at any rate, depending on your warring denomination of Christianity.

Now for spiritual people (those who have an actual communications link with the highest reality, directly and don't let themselves be deceived by some religion), they run into the same problems, but maybe even worse.

It doesn't take much in the way of spiritual practices and life changes, to make that atman positively glow. The student comes to identify with the atman more, and their jiva (human selves) less. They hope that by 'fleeing to the atman' that they can escape from suffering and eventually the 'wheel of life' (samsara).

The only problem there is, that they still have a 'human' weighing them down. If you go completely crazy about liberation as in eastern religions, you actually may achieve moksha/ enlightenment.

Now here's the problem with that. "Enlightenment" is actually an intermediate state of consciousness; don't believe the bull shit. If you are alive, you almost certainly are not fully liberated. (some say that bodhisattvas and other perfected beings can be fully god and fully man, rather like the claims made about Jesus, but that's usually a 'being sold the Brooklyn bridge sort of aspiration).

Myself personally, I did experience Nirvikalpa Samadhi (**Nirvikalpa Samadhi** is a profound state of meditation in Hindu and Buddhist traditions, characterized by the complete absence of thought or mental activity. It's often described as a state of pure consciousness, devoid of any objects or content.

Key characteristics of Nirvikalpa Samadhi:

Unification with Brahman: In Hindu philosophy, Nirvikalpa Samadhi is seen as a state of union with Brahman, the ultimate reality.

Absence of thought: There is no mental activity, no thoughts, feelings, or perceptions.

Pure consciousness: The mind is in a state of pure consciousness, without any objects or content.

Bliss: This state is often associated with a deep sense of bliss and tranquility.)

What 'they' (most spiritual teachers) don't tell you, is that the instant of 'Enlightenment' means that you will die in that instant. I mean, that if you are finished with the 'game of life' (that's what 'Enlightenment' means, then you necessarily have to die. I know that I did.

Some few 'dummies' come back. I know that i did, after about what? I'm not certain. I just know all of the heat left my body form the feet flowing upwards and my heart stopped.

That seemed pretty dead to me.

So I won't bore you with what I saw, and what happened. NDE (near death experiences) are all different and are like assholes, everyone has one (or dies at any rate) and they all differ, they all 'stink'. Why is this? That's a great question and I won't address it in this essay, but it is certainly addressed in Platonic Surrealism.

So I did come back... and it took months to learn to walk and talk properly again; Now I had an MRI and there was no brain damage, so I don't know, might have only lasted 5 minutes. But who knows. Rigor mortis seemed to be setting in, which would indicate something more like 12 hours, but scientific Kevin won't accept that, that sounds ridiculous.

If you DO manage to learn the trick of walking around so changed after coming back from death (some folks 'die' without physically dying I guess, it must have been my first time doing it, I wasn't practiced enough apparently), **then your problems have just begun.**

Pretty much nobody can help explain this stuff. If you are very lucky and were born as part of a tight cultural identity that knows about this stuff, like Zen or Tao, then experienced folks who have also experienced this, or at least studied some above average cultural books may be able to stabilize you.

The problem even then, is that such traditions often 'wash away the personality and the 'ego' as this reduces the suffering caused by a 'glowing atman' and a suffering jiva. If you make yourself 'dead while living' then the 'real death' will have no sting.

It does sort of work, but NOT COMPLETELY.

And that's if you want to walk around as what I call a 'mushroom head'. You may have the peace that passes understanding — but not one hundred percent. You can't get more than ninety nine percent, as the 'ego' (jiva) refuses to give up the last one percent. This is a known thing, and is used as an excuse why some "supposedly enlightened teachers' feel like its' a good idea to buy a few dozen Bentley's and to have wild sex with all their cute young students. I mean, the teacher is screwing the pretty girls (or boys) for their own benefit, they say they are 'transferring shaktipat' through Tantric sex, or whatever the excuse is. And eventually, even a relatively 'Enlightened teacher' often slips back into sex, drugs and rock and roll like a rock star. Not always. But often.

So really, I think that it's fair to say, that maybe NOBODY has solved his problem.

As Jeffrey J. Kripal says, 'the human is two' and he's so correct.

With all Possible Sincerity, this is an Unsolved Issue we must Solve!

That's why I remembered Platonic Surrealism. I can't promise that it will work for anyone else, but it worked for me. I first started remembering Platonic Surrealism about fifty years ago, when i was twelve. It has increasingly become more clear to me, as the information kept transferring from my right brain hemisphere (the more 'big picture' and creative), to my left brain hemisphere (the logical and verbal).

In short, my 'Jiva' had to remember a stabilization system, and to put it into place as my new, self-remembered and (relatively) perfected superego (a term coined by Sigmund Freud in his psychoanalytic theory. It represents the moral component of the personality, often referred to as the "conscience." The superego develops during childhood as a result of internalizing societal rules and parental values.)

How this works could well use a full book to describe, but it is in fact extraordinarily simple.

The human tendency is to confuse 'Awareness' (the highest aspect of being, beyond space, time and normal thought, functionally 'atman/brahman' in a rough sense, and which is mediated by the right brain hemisphere) with the contents of the left brain hemisphere, the jiva/ego sense of self.

Then really every religion and spiritual system in the world ever, at least except a few dangerous old systems which pervert things, has you attempt to WEAKEN THE EGO,

which is just bollocks. The ego is the tool which can stabilize the "human is two", by

surrendering (yet structuring a bit) to the 'big picture self' (the right brain hemisphere).

Platonic Surrealism has you STRENGTHEN THE EGO, not weaken it. But strengthen it in a particular way. The 'replacement superego/ego' (the two become almost one) says and sees this; "I am also that". I am pure Awareness. I am that which is beyond time and space and normal consciousness. I am atman and I am one with Brahman. I am also 'that' when pointing in the 'direction' of the 'regular physical world and her peoples'.

Then the ego is at peace. It never needs to wonder what it is, or need to change in any way.

Jlva becomes 'synchronized' with atman/Brahman (Id (the primal unconscious desires), Ego and Superego+ the 'larger life).

It doesn't mean that you won't suffer any more... you still feel physical, emotional and mental pain sometimes, but in your core, your deepest core, you start to heal.

It does take time. The healing takes time.

But the pain caused by separation and confusion, the pain caused by a flip-flopping self goes away.

The Atman purposely lowers the 'heavenly light and sound' down to a level that one of it's beloveds, the jiva can support, and over time the jiva learns to communicate with the atman better in return.

'God' learns to love HIM/HER Self.

'God' and man (woman, etc.) learn to stop being a butt much, and to live in peace with themselves.

This is the promise of Platonic Surrealism.

How the Phenomenon Talks to Us

The Phenomenon talks to us "Imaginally" as Jeffrey J. Kripal so beautifully discusses in his more recent books, including in *How to Think Impossibly: About Souls, UFOs, Time, Belief, and Everything Else*, Jeffrey J. Kripal, University of Chicago Press, of which I am his co-author for chapter 3.

Understanding Purpose in Life

Ancient Times

Because if you failed, life would be brutal, short and overwhelming. The meaning of life was to survive as part of a group. You personally didn't necessarily have to become an expert at bonking dangerous animals and snakes on the head, or other invading tribes. You could be specialized in planting or crafting and what not, and other more athletic and warlike people could protect you.

Now there are other phases we went through, such as the pastoral, the agriculturist, the industrialist and the post industrialist phases. But for the purpose of this essay, we don't need to cover them, as the seeds of the 'problem of purpose' becomes rapidly obvious.

When you don't live for very long, and your largest focus is on mere survival, and you are part of a group — then you do that stuff. Pretty much everyone has the same purpose. You don't have to find it; nature has defined it for you.

The Modern Day

In the modern day, things have radically changed. The owners of resources and the means of production have corralled us like mindless beasts to work for them, and to transfer the greater portion of our work, which we do to survive, in order to service them. That's the effective 'real' purpose of our lives.

Now a few people accumulate wealth and power, and the purpose of their lives is different; it is to step all over the 'effectively slave humans' (the workers) and to feed on them, so that they have the leisure to kerfuffle over their purpose, which often involves things like secretly trafficking children for sex and the like. Oh, I know that I'm making an overgeneralization, not everyone is a 'slave' like Nietzsche classified, and that not all 'masters' (robber barons, tech billionaires, old money) like Nietzsche called them, pure assholes. But the general characterization is true enough.

Really, we are now in a kleptocracy, global elite-run techno feudal arrangement now, pretty much globally (some countries are better than others obviously). But really other than in a couple of ways, things are not that much different from earlier phases of human life.

We must obey or be killed. Oh, it might take a while. For example, in America, it's still pretty much illegal to drive and be black in large parts of the country. Or to speak up about civil rights to any degree. The one part of the Uniparty just takes rights away from women and minorities as best they can, while the other part of the Uniparty actually does some good, but it ensures that the corporate overlords are kept solidly ensconced in control ('for the good of society').

Now the lower-class people in America (let's focus on America for our examples) mostly think about survival, which is good, as it is a struggle. Now these folks DO 'kerfuffle' over the meaning of life, as they would like a 'better deal', which is why poverty and religion often go together. If this life sucks, then fantasize about another one, to make yourself feel better. That's an oversimplification, but it still works.

The middle-class people are historically the ones who think the most about their purpose in life, much like the lower class in ways, but since they have much more free time, and often much less survival stress, they can afford to ruminate on their purpose.

In a certain sense, a purpose can be to make more money, accumulate one's power and social status and to climb the human hierarchical dominance structure, to survive 'better'. That was the 'grand lie of America' for some years; a carrot in front of the donkey, to get us to produce more for the 'masters'. And indeed, for a short while one man (it was always a man then, as women had few rights) could work an average job, stay with one employer for most of his life, buy a house, raise a family, and retire with a paid company pension.

Those days are gone.

The Relatively Near Future

The increasing sucking sounds of wealth transfer to the masters keeps increasing inexorably. Now with AI, within what? 30 years? There won't' be any more need for human workers, so they probably will just be exterminated by the masters.

The only remaining problem, other than a few technical issues with AI and robots, that are quickly being solved, is how to keep capitalism alive (the dimwits can only understand the acquisition of wealth via this system, like mindless 'ferengi' from Star Trek.) If they kill off the consumers, who will be left to give them money?

UBI (universal basic income) won't work, as the goal is to kill people and take their stuff, not to give them stuff. This is the primal human behavior since forever.

So the ultimate solution will be capitalism that only occurs between the masters, those what? Maybe 10,000 people globally, and eventually like in a science fiction story I read once, androids will be built to be consumers, in a manner of speaking. ANYTHING but to provide for a person and his/her family a living. That is anathema!

It won't be computers who start this slavery, it will be the human masters, though eventually the line between humans and AI will be very blurred eventually.

If you think this is too fantastic, look at yourself now. We are all functionally chained to the Internet/Al via our cell phones. I'd bet that even the Dahli Llama spends significant hours on his smart phone, at least when nobody is looking.

Add in big data analysis of our desires, and microtargeted content online, and we are already effectively controlled by 'the masters' and increasingly by Al. It's just that we are carrying around our control device, it isn't implanted yet.

In short, most of us are finding our purpose in life like in the earliest days again. Inexorable forces are controlling us (like nature once did) and we adapt the best that we can.

History may not repeat, but it rhymes; (often attributed to Mark Twain, but nobody knows for sure).

Analysis

So, is this our future? Sure. It certainly is somewhere, sometime, and since we all live in ALL worlds simultaneously, it's certainly happening right now. That's why I can tell you about it.

Some of the variations aren't half bad; in one everyone is given a 'free' 'tiny' house, and the link to the Al isn't so intrusive. There are even a few humans rights! This may well be another tiny step, those tiny houses 🙄

The question always is however, "But Kev! Is this OUR future? Can you see the future?". I'd say that all of us can see the future, and in fact all the futures (one some level). But if you want to enjoy a good movie, you have to set it up to watch one movie at a time, or it spoils the experience.







None at all.






We Have Never been a Christian Nation


we lost all view of the actual Jesus.

Relationships Between Kundalini Yoga and Sensory Changes in Autism

Now, do you have a spiritual system say, that points to the 'wordless' — great. That has value. But the systems of words in and of themselves only bring suffering. There is all this 'doing things right' and 'doing things wrong'. You can't get away from it. It makes you feel trapped in time, on a hamster mill that you can't escape.

Really, if you want to use Platonic Surrealism as a framework, the way it works is that you learn to enter the Trace state, and to otherwise heal yourself WITHOUT USING OR NEEDING WORDS. Then if you fall out of the Trace state, and you need words to comfort yourself, you remember what Platonic Surrealism says and know there is very little that you need to know, and you already know it. Then you can go back to the Trace state, or just hide, seek or play in any other way that you want to. But if that hide, seek or play involves words, then you risk suffering. Now suffering can be just fine; in fact, it's it's very own practice which is called Acceptance, and it is very valuable.

Now of course people had been talking this way since Kenneth Arnold was misquoted about something he saw near Mount Rainier, Washington

in 1947. The 'objects were assumed to be metallic as they glinted in the sun, and were flying faster than 1200 miles per hour. Given improvements in technology late in WWII, it's not an unusual assumption to be made. However later in life Kenneth Arnold recanted, saying they were of a different shape and were alive, and some sort of animal. But nobody wanted to hear that, and they still don't. They want rocket ships like in the movies!

Now, it makes me almost nauseous to bring up the topic of Roswell, but in any case, whatever happened there (it was NOT a nuts and bolts UFO in all likelihood). The story about Roswell had slipped away to nothing within a couple weeks, until Bill Moore and Charles Berlitz in their book,

"The Roswell Incident" came up with a imaginative theory about the balloon crash. (whatever it was, there's little doubt it was a balloon crash, there never were any sizeable chunks of anything found, but just balsa, rubber, duckie shelf paper, etc, at least that's a pretty credible report).

Really, it doesn't make any difference what Roswell was or wasn't. None of the MANY stories about crashed saucers make the slightest difference, except psychologically.

According to what I and others know, all the 'crash talk' is the COVER STORY, not the thing that needs disclosure. All that talk is what KEEPS 'ACTUAL DISCLOSURE' at bay.

People are willing to believe in nuts and bolts UFOS, just like Hollywood had trained them to believe. It's a very exciting and an easy sell.

Now, when 'insiders' say they know a guy, who knows a guy, who saw a nuts and bolts UFO, then everyone howls with glee, just like they have been trained to believe for all these decades.

Now there's the OTHER 'core story' which has elements of truth to it. That story is that the 'Phenomenon' (whatever that is) is like a mind virus that leaps from person to person, like a disease, and get this— that it sometimes produces physical effects. There are elements of truth to this 'other core story'. If you research poltergeists, for example (see: "<u>The Smoking</u> Gun of UFO Disclosure"), you rapidly realize that "Poltergeist effects" and'

"UFOs" are joined at the hip. Now this isn't new to anybody, ever since Jacques Vallee started writing his insightful books, this sort of thing has

been theorized.

The problem with the 'real-ish' core story, is that it absolutely TERRIFIES religious conservatives within the government, as they think it means 'demons' are behind things. It terrifies others who experience 'the Hitchhiker effect', where poltergeist phenomenon follow them home and terrorize their families.

No government want's to admit that the country is being plagued by 'ghosts', and that not only do they know about it, they take it seriously, but can do nothing whatsoever about it, so the core story number one is 'trumpeted far and wide', previously the story was made more powerful by denying it (everybody loves conspiracy theories) and now by admitting it', but, but you will note that all 'evidence', every single time, turns out to

be a documented, intentional fake, a misidentification, or blurry photos shot by Naval aviators. Now as we know, the "Tic Tac" story really opened things up for discussion, and again, truly suspect that those incidents were 'nothing of importance', except in a very unusual way, it has changed everything.

It is, is what I call 'the Stay-Puft Marshallow Man effect' from the movie 'Ghostbusters'. The Philip Experiment

The Philip Experiment

In 1972, Canadian psychologist Dr. A.R.G. Owen and his team conducted an experiment to create a fictional entity through collective imagination and see if it would exhibit paranormal behavior.

Methodology:

- 1. Eight participants, unaware of the true purpose, were asked to imagine and describe a historical figure named "Philip Aylesford."
- 2. They created a fictional biography, personality, and appearance for Philip.
